

1. Insert a new paragraph after “b)” on page 2:

c) Analyze implications for salmon and upstream rivers. Analyze the implications of conveyance and operational options, including a full range of diversion levels, on listed salmon, steelhead and sturgeon species, commercial and recreational fisheries, and upstream riverine habitat.

2. Insert additional sentences after “hydrologic and climactic conditions” in paragraph “d)”:

A greater emphasis on wet season capture will require a more comprehensive set of regulatory requirements for the Delta and upstream tributaries than exists today, in order to ensure the achievement of our co-equal goals. These requirements may necessitate a reduction in average total diversions from the Delta.

3. Insert additional language in paragraph “i)” after “approaches to conveyance, to”

a full range of water quality issues, including salinity, temperature, dissolved oxygen, pesticides and toxics, and turbidity,

4. Insert a new paragraph after existing paragraph “i)”.

j) Develop a baseline that reflects current conditions. Analyses of alternative conveyance infrastructure and operations should be compared against a baseline that reflects current operations and legal requirements.
