San Joaquin County is conducting an evacuation exercise for Reclamation District 17 on November 5th from 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Several field activities will be occurring to evaluate the County Evacuation Mapping Project and to test some new procedures for evacuating persons who lack transportation and institutions. Provisions for observers have been made to include a tour of several sites of activities.

Since the Delta Task Force has expressed an interest in public safety, the County would invite members to participate in the tour and actually see some of the preparedness activities that are going on. Observers would meet at the San Joaquin County Office of Emergency Services, 2101 E. Earhart Avenue, Stockton where they will receive a briefing and the tour.
