Dear Delta Vision:

This is a comment to your June 18, 2008 draft Delta Vision Strategic Plan (the “**Plan**”).

1. If the Delta Protection Commission will be making land use decisions, members of the DPC should be elected by the residents of the Delta. Do you agree with the statement in the prior sentence and why, or why not?
2. How will terrestrial endangered/protected species, both fauna and flora, be projected by the actions suggested in the draft Plan?
3. To what extent does the “diverse mosaic of habitats and ecosystem processes” (page 5, line 10) include terrestrial fauna and flora? Why or why not?
4. The loss, costs and harm (including loss, costs and harm to agricultural, economic, habitat resources now existing).
5. The Delta’s legacy towns will be turned into another suburbia set up as an island, rather than a town supporting, and supported by, surrounding agricultural and economic interests.

6. With ring levees isolating the Delta legacy towns, they will suffer from significant fall-off of police and fire protection.
